- Feng Shui Considerations
- Land + Clearing Ceremonies

Full-Service Scope of Work (example)

<u>Intake</u>

- Review existing drawings + documents, as needed
- Initial research (site, neighborhood, surrounding landscape)
- Meeting with design team and/or clients for scope + objectives
- SOW & Estimate

Deliverable: Scope of Work and Estimate

- project understanding
- detailed Scope of Work
- Estimate

PHASE 1: Planning & Programming

- Additional research based on Intake
- 1-2 Meetings with design team
 - Site visit (in person or virtual)
- Redline existing and new documents
- Initial report/ Client presentation

Deliverables: Redlined Drawings, Initial Report/Presentation

Assessment and recommendations based on existing conditions (site, area, building), client needs, and collaboration with design team. May include:

- wellness focus/ objectives, based on intake
- existing + potential infractions and imbalances, recommendations
 - o site, building
 - o clients + lifestyle
- geometry, proportion and environmental considerations, recommendations
 - o ordering system/ site geometry input
 - o general Elements* and spatial feel
 - o sun/shade studies and weather review (studies provided by design team)

PHASE 2: Concept/ Schematic

- 1-2 Meetings with design team and/ or clients
- Material health: initial research
- Review concept design + redline
- Updated Report/ Presentation

Deliverables: Redlined Drawings, Updated Report

Updates to Initial Report and recommendations, may include:

- respond to infractions from Phase 1, if any
- material considerations
- sensory design considerations
- well-being feature/intervention recommendations

PHASE 3: Design Development

- 3-6 Meetings with design team/ clients + relevant consultants (Landscape, MEP, etc)
- Materials: research + BOD
 - o material health
 - o Elements for balance
- Sensory Design (lighting, acoustics, thermal, scent)
- Review drawings/ plans + redline
- Expanded report/ Presentation

Deliverables: Redlined Drawings, Expanded Report, Standards

May include:

- outline recommendations + solutions in design
- CD considerations (acoustics, fastening, envelope, insulation, etc)
- standards for consultants (lighting, ventilation, water filtration, etc)
- material standards/ BOD (material specification is additional service)

PHASE 4: Construction Documents (If Needed)

- Review drawings/ plans + redline
- 1-2 Meetings with design team + contractor
- Material revisions

PHASE 5: Construction Admin (If Needed)

- Groundbreaking Ceremony
- 1-2 Site visits
- 1-2 Meetings with design team + contractor
- Material sample review/ revisions
